Questions:

Q: The South Exterior Elevation shows a Type 'S3' Awning Window but the Door and Window schedule shows the Type 'S3' Window as being a fixed (non-operable) window A: Exterior windows type S3 to be awning windows per exterior elevations

Q: The floor plan shows an interior Type 'S3' Window in Office 'A101.' Are the Type 'S3' Windows Awning Windows or fixed like shown on the schedule?

A: Exterior to have an awning, window towards the vestibule to have a slider, a window toward garage bays to be fixed

Q: Is Tubelite an approved equal for aluminum storefronts? A: yes

Q: Door A105.1 is shown to be 3'-3/4" wide please confirm A: the door to be standard 3'-0"x7'-0" door with transom per window schedule



Q: The PEMB buildings do NOT come with epoxy primer, only standard primer. Addendum 2 states that is acceptable, however, addendum 3 seems to indicate that epoxy primer is required?

A: Provide standard primer on the primary and secondary framing

Q: Are the light duty and heavy duty asphalt the same? The plans show they are. Please confirm
